

Ceremony: 12 total, 6 ground pieces for floor arch, 6 aisle pieces.



The look



with these flowers

RECIPE (each ground piece gets the following):

- 5 red roses
- 2 light pink roses
- 2 white roses
- 5 red carnations
- 3 pink carnations
- 2 white carnations
- $\frac{1}{3}$ - $\frac{1}{2}$ bunch baby's breath
- 2 white mums
- 5 delphinium
- 3 white stock
- $\frac{1}{2}$ bunch greenery

How-to: 1. create the boxes w/chicken wire and tape. 2. Place greenery and baby's breath to create a base (note for floor arch pieces, make sure these pieces cover the box/mechanics). 3. Place delphinium. 4. Place roses. 5. Place carnations. 6. Place stock. 7. Place mums.

Boutonnieres: baby's breath and spray rose, with ribbon tied like the middle image. Not wrapped all the way to the bottom with tape or ribbon, just tied with tiny ribbon.



RECIPE (if enough flowers, make 1-2 extras of each color):

Cast-off piece of baby's breath

1-2 spray roses (red or pink for groomsmen- 11, white for family- 7) cut with 2" stem

1 piece of greenery

How-to: bunch greenery, baby's breath, and spray rose/s then tape. Wrap tape with ribbon and tie.

Corsages:

Corsages: Two spray roses plus baby's breath and a couple pieces of greenery. All glued to wrist corsage.



RECIPE:

leftover spray roses and carnations

Leftover baby's breath

Two greenery leaves

How-to: Hot glue leaves to cover plastic oval. Glue roses/carnations. Glue baby's breath on either side.

Bouquets: Bridal bouquet is modern, almost all roses or all roses (~15 roses). Bridesmaids have bouquets smaller than the brides (8 roses).



RECIPE:

Red roses (Bride-6, Bridesmaids-4)

Pink roses (Bride-4, Bridesmaids-2)

White roses (Bride-2, Bridesmaids-2)

Baby's breath- Bride-.5 bunch, Bridesmaids-1-2 stems

How-to: fluff and reflex roses, remove all greenery and guard petals, use spiral method to arrange (Maddie will show how to), once spiraled adjust stem height so back roses are lifted higher and front roses are pulled lower, wrap with waterproof tape, wrap with ribbon and tie, cut stems longer and all at same length.

Bud Vases: 1 rose or carnation per bud vase



RECIPE:

33 red roses (reflexed)

17 pink roses (reflexed)

17 white roses (reflexed)

22 red carnations

12 pink carnations

7 white carnations

11 in cocktail area, rest on tables

How-to: prep all flowers then set aside for wedding day.

RECIPE:

5 red roses

3 pink roses

2 white roses

5 red carnations

3 pink carnations

2 white carnations

A few stems of baby's breath

A few stems of greenery

How-to: place greenery and some baby's breath to make base shape, add in roses to continue shape, back-fill with carnations and baby's breath leftovers.
